


- High Desert Area of Southern California
- Over 100 square miles + Population of almost 170,000= Low Population Density (Oakland is 78.03 square miles with a population of 425,195)

Effectiveness of Living Document



- Allows the team to "call audibles"
 - Change priorities.
 - Adjust or delete what isn't working.
 - Adjust implementation schedules as needed.
 - Add new efforts as needs or scenarios change.

Changing Priorities - Geofencing




Argument for Geofencing



- No studies on effectiveness to address illegal dumping
- At time, staff only found case study for auto dealers.
 - Would create geofences around competitors.
 - Would send targeted outreach to potential car buyers.
 - Saw increase in sales.





Sting Operations – Where?





- Empty lot clean-up


